

Position Statement on Air Quality

Baker Hughes manages our air emissions consistent with industry best practices and regulatory standards. Our comprehensive internal policy for protecting air quality outlines procedures to identify, assess, control and mitigate potential sources of emissions from our processes and operations. These measures are intended to ensure regulatory compliance and protect human health and the environment.

We have an internal *Air Emissions Management* procedure which details how we identify and evaluate air emission sources. Evaluations include the completion of an air assessment, determination of permitting requirements, identification of regulatory compliance requirements, identification of control methods and maintenance of emissions control equipment, calculation of air emissions and reporting of air emissions. Our procedures define the process and establish the requirements to minimize and manage the discharge of permitted air emissions.

We disclose our air emissions annually within our annual Corporate Sustainability Report.
